

June 1st & 2nd, 2019 Mule Mania Contestant General Rules

- Classes for Contestants over 18 years of age is \$10.00
- Classes for Contestants 17 years and under will be \$5.00

POST ENTRIES: Contestants already registered may add classes.

If adding additional classes, they must be added **IN THE OFFICE** at least “3 classes ahead.”

If competing for “Hi-Point Awards”, all classes required for that age division must be entered by 7:30 AM. Any late entries will not count towards Hi-Point.

A limited number of RV spaces with water and electricity are available. NO MULES ARE ALLOWED IN THE RV SPACES OR IN ON THE GRASS IN THE INFIELD. Please fill out your entry form or call the Dayton Chamber to reserve. Paid, reserved camping will have first choice. **ALL CHECKS NEED TO BE MADE PAYABLE TO MULE MANIA.**

DRY CAMPING/STOCK TRAILER PARKING: There will be 20 X 40 ft camping spaces issued. The fee is \$10 per night.

MULES & DONKEYS ONLY. NO HORSES ALLOWED IN THE Mule Mania Show

STALLS: All animals must be stalled each night. Stalls are available at \$12 per day which includes 2 bags of bedding pellets. Additional bags can be pre-ordered or purchased at the show for \$5 per bag.

COLUMBIA COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS

Directions: Located on the West end of Dayton, North of Main Street, next to the County Golf Course. From Hwy 12, look for the brown fairgrounds sign and turn on Pine St. Go just two blocks north and cross the railroad tracks, turn left to contestant’s entrance. These are clean, well-kept grounds. Please pick up any garbage before you leave.

TRANSPORTATION PAPERWORK: Owners are encouraged to have a current brand inspection, current Coggins, and Health papers.

HEALTH OF ANIMALS: At the discretion of the Show Committee, a veterinarian may be asked to inspect animals at the expense of the owner or exhibitor before competition, to determine that the animal is free from any infection or contagious disease or parasites. Please be aware that ringworm, warts, pinkeye, strangles, contagious ecthyma, scabies, lice, mites, ticks, and fleas, all fit into these categories. No animal that is sick or lame will be allowed to show and will be asked to leave the grounds.

GATE HOLDS: A **3 minute maximum** gate hold will be allowed between classes, if you need additional time. You must notify the gate person at least **1 class ahead**.

CANCELLATION OF CLASSES: Show Management reserves the right to change, combine, or cancel any classes.

DRESS: Appropriate attire must be worn in all classes. Performance and Halter Classes require long pants, boots, long sleeve western shirt and western hat. Show Committee does not require, but encourages helmets in all riding or driving classes.

EQUIPMENT/TACK: The use of mechanical hackamores, tie downs, running martingales, draw reins, nosebands, or other training equipment and using 2 hands with a curb bit, will cause elimination in performance classes. This equipment will be allowed in gaming events and driving events.

UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT: The Mule Mania Association and Show Committee have the right to excuse any animal or handler from the arena who show abuse, unmanageability, profane language, or unsportsmanlike conduct. This will be strictly enforced.

ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEASH OR CONFINED. PLEASE BE CONSIDERATE OF YOUR NEIGHBORS AND CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG. NO DOGS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE CHUCK WAGON, COOKING AREAS, GRANDSTANDS, OR VENDOR BOOTHS.
